VOTING ACTIVITIES FOR Q2 2020 - SUMMARY

- Our Stock Pickers exercise the voting rights in respect of the stocks in which they have invested for the Company.
- Between 1 April 2020 and 30 June 2020, the Stock Pickers cast 2220 votes at 125 company meetings.
- Our Stock Pickers voted on all of the 2220 proposals that could be voted on in the quarter.
- The Company's Stock Pickers voted against management on 197 proposals and abstained on 15.
- Of the votes exercised against management, the key topics voted on were director related and non-salary compensation related.
- In addition to providing this quarterly update on voting activities by its Stock Pickers, the Company reports on its responsible investment strategy to its shareholders in its Annual and Interim Reports. This reporting includes details of how the Company has engaged with its investee companies as well as how its Stock Pickers have exercised its voting rights.



Voting Summary




- Votes exercised against Management






